




RCDE STADIUM




RCDE STADIUM

WHITE AND BLUE HISTORY

MOMENTS OF OUR HISTORY

Over the course of the tour we will also visit the memorable club's historical room. The room, named after Ricardo Zamora, is the perfect scenario to learn about RCDE's history. There you could find the most important assortment of cups, trophies, pictures and other meaningful objects the club has gathered from the very beginning to the present.

The historical room pays tribute to all the successful football events of our history, but so too is a place for honouring the memory of other sport sections that have previously been part of the club but no longer exist.

Further to this, nearby to this room we will find the corridor that links the dressing room with the mixed zone where you could find an exhibition with most of the jerseys that have been worn by the first team from 1900 to the present year.



FIRST TEAM DRESSING ROOM

The tour will continue visiting one of the most private and most modern areas of the Stadium. We will head towards the area where the first team warms up before jumping into the pitch.

You will be amazed by the Stadium facilities for its modernity and style. A dressing room that meets the standards of excellence and has all the amenities for having our players at their best shape.

You will be able to experience the same feeling as the players of Espanyol before every match and sit on the chair of you favourite one!

You will have the chance to pretend being the new signing of the team and answer questions in a press drill!

Likewise, you will see on display the pictures of the most iconic players of our history and every coach that has lead the first team since 1929.

MIXED ZONE

We will have the chance to visit the mixed zone which is the place where press conferences take place after every match.



JERSEY CORRIDOR

This corridor that leads to the dressing room, has on display the 104 jerseys that have been worn by the first team from 1900 to the present year,





RICARDO ZAMORA HISTORICAL ROOM

We will stop in the middle of the jersey corridor, to visit the Historical Room, named after Ricardo Zamora, the best goal-keeper of our history.

In this room, we have on display all important cups, photographs. and other obiects of the history Espanyol. The ones that are important to highlight are the 4 Spanish Cups (1929, 1940, 2000 and 2006). Macava's Cups from 1902/03 and 1903/04, which was the first football competition in Spain, and two runner up plaques from playing the final match of the UEFA Cup (1988 and 2007).

Tour participants will also see on display, a specific zone devoted to other sports that were part of this Club but no longer exist.



PRESIDENT ROOM


We will visit Ángel Rodríguez bust, founder of RCD Espanyol, and tour participants will get to know the beginnings of the Club.

What's more, we will visit the zone devoted to preserve the institutional memory, where we can find on display the presidents that have been part of our history, starting with Ángel Rodríguez and finishing with the current president, Chen Yansheng.

PRESIDENTIAL BOX

In front of the President Room, we will find the Presidential Box where we will enjoy the breathtaking views of the RCDE Stadium.

AUDIOVISUAL ROOM

In this room we will travel through time and you will discover and understand our roots, get to know our background and the reason why we are so emotionally attached to this Club and the sentiment for its colours.

Furthermore, we count on a 360° audiovisual room that makes this unique experience a thrill for our fans and has the potential to amaze young and old alike.



EXECUTIVE ZONE

The middle grandstand holds the VIP area, and it's the place where we canfind the private rooms of our sponsors and other companie.

In this part of the Stadium, we will find the Experience Box, also known as LaLiga Showroom.

From this room you will see the football pitch and the place where the main cameras broadcast every match.




DANI JARQUE ZONE
